

**2024 Wisconsin Masters Games SCY at the RAC
Qualifier Meet for the National Senior Games
Saturday, September 14th, 2024**

SPONSORED BY: The Wisconsin Masters Games. WMG is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that provides a swim meet where the age 50+ athlete can qualify for the National Senior Games swim meet held on alternate years. Website (WiMastersGames.org) Any questions about this event should be directed to WMG.

RECOGNIZED BY: Wisconsin LMSC for USMS, Inc. Recognition No. 204-R001
A USMS recognized event is a swim meet where the USMS Rules of Competition are followed but USMS full membership is not required. If a swimmer is a USMS member, times achieved are reported upward to USMS for all considerations (Top 10, USMS Records), plus times are eligible for LMSC records.

LOCATION: Rameriz Aquatic Center (RAC) at the

PARKING AT THE POOL: Park & enter on the east side of the Aquatic Center. The RAC is entered through the pool doors, not the school doors. The RAC building wing is south of the school building area.

TIME: Doors Open at noon, Warm-up noon-12:55 PM, Meet starts at 1:00 PM.

ENTRY OPTIONS: Enter On-Line via WMG Website ([WiMastersGames.org \(fusesport.com\)](http://WiMastersGames.org(fusesport.com)))
OR contact WMG for a mail-in entry form.

FACILITIES: USMS-measured 25 yard, 10 lane pool with depth of 2 meters for the entire pool. The length of the competition course is in compliance and on file with USMS.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all swimmers over 40 years old. USMS membership is not required. Be advised that the National Senior Games is for competitors over 50 years old.

RULES: Official U.S. Masters Swimming Rules will govern this meet. All events will be timed finals.

TECHNICAL SWIMSUITS: Rule 102.12.1 C "Only swimsuits complying with World Aquatics swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USMS-sanctioned or -recognized competition."

SEEDING: Heats will be seeded slowest to fastest, gender and age groups combined. An "NT" is not allowed for an entry. Please estimate your time based on your workouts. Heat sheets will not be provided, but will be posted around the pool and uploaded to Meet Mobile.

SCRATCHES: If a swimmer fails to swim in his/her assigned heat and lane for an event, the swim will be marked as NS (No Show) and the swimmer will not be allowed to compete in the remaining heats of the event even if there are empty lanes. An exception may be made at the discretion of the official if there has been an error by the official or a meet worker that caused the swimmer to fail to swim in the assigned heat and lane.

TIMING: Electronic timing (SST) (primary: automatic) backed up by one button (secondary: semi-automatic) and one watch (tertiary). This level of timing meets requirements for setting USMS Records.

AUTOMATIC SPLIT RECORDING: There will not be any automatic split recording. Splits must be requested in writing by the swimmer as per USMS rules noted on the USMS Split Notification Form (**Appendix B, Page 135 of the 2024 USMS Rule Book**).

WARM-UP PROCEDURE: Both the competition and youth pools will be available for warmup during the entire warmup time. After the warmup time, the lanes not blocked off will be available for continuous warm down. The warm down will probably be in lanes 7-10 unless the competition needs to use lanes 1-6, in which case, warm down will be available in lanes 8-10. All non-competition lanes, both pools included, are circle swim only. **NO DIVE STARTS OR BACKSTROKE STARTS** from the blocks or deck in circle swim lanes. Entry into the pool must be feet first in a cautious manner.

ENTRY FEES: Please refer to the WMG website for fees. There is a \$40 registration fee which entitles you to enter 2 other sports besides swimming. There is a \$30 swimming sport fee. The first two swims are free. But, swims 3-6 are \$8 per swim. There is also a \$5 processing fee. If you were to enter 3 events, the total cost would be \$40 + \$30 + \$0 + \$0 + \$8 + \$5 for a total of \$83. You may also add a donation via the online registration. From the WMG website ... "As a small non-profit organization, the WMG relies on the revenue generated during our game season and donations from our athletes. The WMG does not receive any federal, state, or county funding."

ENTRY LIMIT: Six (6) individual events, There are no relays or time trials. Swimmers in the 500 will need to check-in and also find a person to count laps.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Please check the WMG website for the most current information. Swimming registration closes September 4, 2024.

AWARDS: INDIVIDUAL EVENTS: Medals 1st-3rd place.

CONCESSIONS: No concessions are available. Bring along your water bottle and preferred meet snacks.

MEET RESULTS: The USMS Event Rankings and Individual Results website will be updated with the results of all USMS member swims. Meet Mobile will have results published during the meet. The WMG website will have all the final results published. WMG will submit results to the National Senior Games organization.
