Facility: The pool is an 8-lane, 25-yard pool with seven foot wide lanes and non-turbulent lane lines. The finish end of the pool is 7 feet deep; the turn end of the pool is 12 feet 6 inches deep. The length of the competition course without a bulkhead is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 107.2.1.

Events: all events will be seeded into Mixed heats, from slowest seed time to fastest seed time. 500 Free may be limited by number of entries. Relay events may be swum as either all Men or all Women or Mixed (two Men plus two Women). Swimmers must be entered in an individual event to enter relays. Relays are due by 9:30am.

ELIGIBILITY: Current USMS rules will govern the meet. All participants must be age 18 or older, and be currently-registered members of U.S. Masters Swimming. Foreign swimmers must provide proof of current membership in their country's Masters Swimming governing body.

Timing: The primary timing system will be manual timing with two watches. Times from this competition will be eligible for USMS Top 10 consideration, but not for world or USMS records.

AGE-DETERMINING DATE: The swimmer's age group is determined by their age on the last day of the meet
