

## 2025 TEAM Eugene Summer LCM Swim Meet

**Rules:** 2025 USMS and OMS rules shall be in effect.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible for competition, including participating in warm-ups, members must be 18 years of age or older as of May 18, 2025. This event is open to all 2025 USMS or foreign registered swimmers 18 or over. Foreign registered swimmers must provide proof of current registration with their country's governing body for Masters swimming. Unregistered swimmers **may** sign up for a 2025 USMS membership before registering for this meet, and may register online at [www.usms.org/join](http://www.usms.org/join) - this membership is valid through 2025. One Event Membership is not available.

**Recognized Meet:** As a Recognized meet, swimmers are **NOT** required to be members of a registered masters federations such as USMS. No insurance is in effect. Times recorded by USMS member swimmers will be eligible for USMS Top Ten and records, but not for AQUA if USMS rules are followed and there is a designated Observer Report on file. Time recorded by unregistered swimmers are not eligible for USMS nor AQUA consideration.

**Age groups:** 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, etc.. Relay age groups: 72-99, 100-119, 120-159, 160-199, 200-239, 240-279... Your competition age is your age on December 31, 2025. Age group is based on the swimmer's age as of December 31, 2025.

**Location:** Amazon Pool, 2600 Hilyard St, Eugene, OR 97405. 50-meter outdoor pool, 8-lane, with 9 feet wide lanes. Depth 3.6' - 13.2'. Starting blocks at the deep end. Touchpads at both ends. Colorado timing system. At least 1 lane(s) will be available for continuous wu/wd.

**Pool Length Compliance:** The length of the competition course without a bulkhead is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1.

**TIMING SYSTEM:** The primary timing system will be automatic timing with back-up button(s) and watch(s). Times by registered Masters swimmers will be eligible for USMS and AQUA Top Ten and records consideration.

**Entry Fee:** \$35.00. Online entries are paid by credit card to "Oregon Masters".

**Entry Limit:** Each swimmer is limited to four (4) individual events and 1 relay per relay block.

**Entry Deadline:** Entries must be received by May 13, 2025 at 11:59.59 pm.

**Refunds:** Refunds will be considered in accordance with Oregon Masters Swimming Policies and Procedures. Contact OMS Vice-Chair ([pwindrath1@comcast.net](mailto:pwindrath1@comcast.net)) if you need more information.

**Schedule:** Sunday, May 18, 2025. This event follows an age group meet. Therefore, the start times listed below are estimates and will be confirmed several days before the meet.

- Estimated Warm-up: 3:00 – 4:00 pm
- Estimated Competition: 4:00 – 7:00 pm

**Warm-up/warm down Procedures:** Swimmers are required to enter the water feet first in a safe and cautious manner (do not jump aggressively). In accordance with OMS policies, training equipment (paddles, snorkels, fins, pull buoys, kick boards, etc.) is not allowed in warm-up nor in the continuous wu/wd lanes. At an appropriate time, a lane(s) will be made available for Starts and one-way sprints. At least 1 lane will be available for wu/wd throughout the competition.

**Meet Program:** The Meet Program will be emailed to participants several days before the meet and include additional information. Rosters and heat sheets will be available on Meet Mobile and [SwimPhone](#). Entrants are encouraged to regularly check the [Oregon Masters Swimming](#) website for updates.

**Relays:** Enter relays at the meet. Relays will be Men, Women, and Mixed (2 women, 2 men). Relay entry cards must be submitted before Event 10 – 50 Breaststroke. Swimmers may enter only one Freestyle and one Medley relay. If the meet time line exceeds 3 hours, relays may be dropped.

**Relays:** Due to depth of the Amazon pool at the shallow end, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> swimmers **MUST** start in the water. Therefore, lead-off relays splits are **NOT** eligible for USMS Top Ten nor records.

**Results:** Results will be posted at the pool and will be available online at [www.SwimOregon.org](http://www.SwimOregon.org). Results will also be available on SwimPhone and Meet Mobile after the meet. Results and a meet evaluation will be emailed to all participants 1-2 days after the meet.

**Awards:** OMS ribbons for places 1-3 in individual events will be available.

**Split Requests:** Initial split times from an individual or relay event will be accepted as an individual performance and will be considered for Top 10 if it is deemed an official time. Split times will be considered for a USMS record only if recorded by automatic timing. The request for relay leadoff split times and initial backstroke distance times in individual backstroke events must be made prior to the swim. For all other splits, the swimmer must notify the Meet Referee of the intent to record an initial split time prior to the conclusion of the meet.

**TOBACCO PRODUCTS:** Smoking and use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in locker rooms, in spectator seating and standing areas, and in all areas used by swimmers during the meet and during the warm-up periods in connection with the meet.

**CAMERAS, VIDEO EQUIPMENT, AND DRONES:** The use of cameras, including cell phone cameras and/or other recording devices, is prohibited behind the starting platforms during the start of races including relay starts. The use of audio and/or visual recording devices, including cell phone cameras, is prohibited in changing areas, restrooms, and locker rooms. Operation of drones, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venues (pool, athlete/coach areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

**Order of Events – Sunday, May 18, 2025 (Estimated wu: 3pm, estimated competition: 4-7 pm)**

Due to water depth at shallow end, USMS rules require 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> swimmers to start in the water.
