Our meet does start with the 1650 being held first. Once all heats are completed there will be warm-ups and the rest of the events will proceed. We will have home baked goodies, fruit, as well as items marked as gluten free and if it contains nuts for all participants to enjoy!

**Community project:** Do you have gently used suits that don't fit, have a small tear or are maybe a bit snug, but otherwise are good?! If so, see our flyer regarding a project with MKEREC Swimsuit Drive! Bring suits to our meet and put in a collection bin provided. These suits are then available to underserved populations to encourage swimming!

**Time:** Sunday, March 2, 2025. Doors Open at 8:00 AM, Warm-up 8:00 AM – 8:20 AM;

**Meet Starts at 8:30 AM.** Please note that the WFB Pool is not open before 8:00 AM.

**Check in:** is only required for the 1650 participants at the meet table.

**Continuous Warm-Up and Warm-Down:** There is a diving well, as well open areas outside of the competition lanes.

**Heat Sheets:** Will be posted around the pool and additional copies will be at the meet table free to take until gone.

**Results/Awards:** Will be posted near the pool entrance door and a table with ribbons to be taken on the honor system.

**Facilities:** 6 lane, 25-yard pool with anti-turbulent lane lines, starting blocks and backstroke flags. The length of the competition course is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1, but as a bulkhead course, is subject to length confirmation. Eligibility of times for USMS Top 10 and records will be contingent on verification of bulkhead placement.

**Eligibility/Age Determination Date/Age Group for Individual Events:** Open to all swimmers 18 years or older and be currently registered members of U.S. Masters Swimming or another World Aquatics federation. Age group for individual events are 18-24, 25-29, ...in 5yr increments as high as needed.

There are two membership options:

1. Annual USMS membership for Wisconsin swimmers which is good through 12/31/2025).
2. One Event memberships (OEVT). Online entry is required for One Event memberships. Times swum under one-event registration are not eligible for USMS Top 10 or records consideration. One Event memberships are not eligible for USMS or Wisconsin records (individual or relay), AllAmerican consideration, All-Star consideration or RELAYS.

**Rules:** Current USMS rules will govern the meet. All events will be timed finals. Seeding: Heats will be computer seeded, slowest to fastest. **Except** the 1650 which will be seeded fastest to slowest. Please submit a reasonably accurate seed time. A NO TIME will be seeded in the slowest heat. Age groups and sexes will be combined.

**Timing:** Primary: Automatic electronic timing system (SST Console), Secondary: Semi-automatic two buttons, Tertiary: One watch. Times from this competition will be eligible for USMS records and Top 10 consideration, but not for world records.

**Automatic Split Recording:** Automatic split recording (USMS Rule 103.18.2 A and B) will be performed by the officials for relay lead-off provided the split time is available from the automatic (primary) timing system. Other splits must be requested in writing by the swimmer as per USMS rules noted on the USMS Split Notification Form.

**Entry Fee:** \$5.00 per individual event, plus a \$18.00 facility user fee for all entries. No charge for relays. Online entries are paid by credit card to "Whitefish Bay Masters Meets". Relay-only swimmers must enter the meet with no events, sign the waiver and pay the facility fee. See selection above for Relay-only swimmers.

**Entry Limit:** Six individual events plus relays. 1650yd Freestyle limited to first 24 entrants.

**DECK ENTRIES (on the day of the meet) WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

\*Submit relay entries pre-meet/and or at the meet the meet table. Relays may be all men, all women, or exactly two men and two women. Competitors may swim only once in each relay event. Relay age group is determined by the age of the youngest relay member: 18+, 25+, 35+, 45+ and up in 10 year increments as high as needed.

**Post Meet:** We will gather at the Bavarian Bierhaus where there will be tables reserved for Masters swimmers. It is 5 minutes from the high school to the Bierhaus. From the High school go north on Marlborough Dr to E Henry Clay St. Take a left on E Henry Clay St to N Port Washington Rd. Take a right on N Port Washington Rd. In 0.2 miles take a left on W Lexington Blvd. The first road on your right after going under the over pass is the driveway to The Bavarian Bierhaus – 700 W Lexington Blvd. Glendale, WI 53217
