TIME: **Doors Open** at 9:30 AM, **Warm-up** 10:00-10:50 AM, **Competition starts at 11:00 AM**

NOTE about the Elsmore Pro Shop hours: The shop will be open on Saturday AM. Shop early. You can call the shop at least one week before the meet to arrange for any special sizes or performance suits and they will have your request in inventory. ENTRY DEADLINE: Monday, March 24th, 2025. On-line entries will be cut-off on Monday, March 24, 2025 at 11:59PM central time. NOTE THAT THE ENTRIES CUTOFF, MARCH 24, 2025, IS FIVE (5) DAYS BEFORE THE MEET. Mail-in entries must be received

by **Sat, March 22, 2025**. Mail-in checks must be payable to WSAC.

ENTRY FEE: \$6.00/individual event plus a \$24.00 pool user surcharge. In addition, One-Event Registrations pay the \$20 One-Event Registration fee. Relay-only swimmers must register for the meet, pay the pool user surcharge and acknowledge the waiver. There is no fee to enter a relay team on the day of the meet.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all USMS-Registered Masters Swimmers and College Club Swimmers 18 years old or older. Mail entries must include a copy of the current USMS registration card. **Note that there are three registration options.**

1. **USMS Member Annual Registration** (Register with USMS before entering the meet.)
2. **College Club Swimming Member** (Register with USMS "Bridge" number, Club is your CCS Club.)

3. **USMS One-Event Registration (\$20, plus entry fee per event and pool surcharge).** This registration is for the non-member who wishes to participate in this swim meet only. It entitles the registrant to compete in up to six (6) individual swims at this meet, but it is not an annual USMS athlete registration. Online entry is required for one-event registration. Times swum under one-event registration are not eligible for USMS Top Ten consideration. One-event registrations are also not eligible for USMS or Wisconsin records (individual or relay), All-American or All-Star consideration. One-event swimmers may not swim relays except if the relay is swum as exhibition. One-event registration can be converted to a full USMS annual membership within 30 days of this swim meet by contacting the LMSC Registrar.

ENTRY LIMIT: **Six (6) individual events total**, plus five (5) relays. THE 1650 FREESTYLE WILL BE LIMITED TO THE FIRST 16 ENTRIES RECEIVED. THE 1000 FREESTYLE WILL BE LIMITED TO THE FIRST 16 ENTRIES RECEIVED. If the 1650 OR 1000 is filled, you may submit an e-mail request to the Meet Director to be added to a wait list. Each swimmer entered in the 1650 OR 1000 will be responsible for providing a person to count his/her laps. The 500 split from the 1000 and the 500/1000 splits from the 1650 will be recorded as events, provided times are available from the electronic timing system.

TIME TRIALS: Time trials will not be offered at this meet.

FACILITIES: USMS-Measured 50-meter pool with bulkheads, configured as two 8-lane, 25-yard pools, plus one 2-lane, 20-meter pool. Competition held in 8-lanes of one 25-yard pool. Competition pool water depth: 2 meters (6-1/2 feet) at both start & turn ends. The length of the competition course is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1, but as a bulkhead course, is subject to length confirmation. Eligibility of times for USMS Top 10 and Records will be contingent on verification of bulkhead placement. The bulkhead placement has always met USMS pool length.

TIMING: Electronic timing using **SST Console (primary: automatic)** backed up by **two**

buttons (secondary: semi-automatic) and two watches (tertiary). This level of timing meets requirements for setting USMS Top 10 times. Although USMS Top 10 consideration times can be set with two watch times, USMS Records can only be set with electronic times (both automatic and semi-automatic)..

AUTOMATIC SPLIT RECORDING: Automatic split recording (USMS Rule 103.18.2 A . B, C and D) will be performed by the officials for relay leadoff splits, the 500 split from the 1000 freestyle and the 500/1000 freestyle splits from the 1650 freestyle event, provided the split time is available from the automatic (primary) timing system. Other splits must be requested in writing by the swimmer per USMS rules noted on the USMS Split Notification Form from Appendix A, Page 133, of the 2025 USMS Rule Book. The relay leadoff split is automatic only for the first entire relay leg and not for splits within the leadoff leg. If splits within a leadoff leg are desired, the swimmer must request splits in writing.

RELAYS: Submit relays at the meet. The relay events are noted as Mixed by this online entry system, but the relay teams may be all men, all women or mixed (2 men & 2 women). Swimmers may swim 5 relays, but, swimmers may not swim both the mixed and the male/female relays of a given distance. Relay events (men, women, mixed) are combined under one event number. Relays are free, no cost to enter. If you know your relays in advance of the meet, please e-mail the relays to the Meet Director before the meet. You may change the names or order on the relay card before the relay is started.

SEEDING: Heats will be seeded slowest to fastest, gender and age groups combined. Please submit a reasonably accurate seed time. An “NT” is not allowed for an entry. The 1000/1650 Freestyles are the only check-in events. **Heat sheets will not be provided but will be posted around the pool and uploaded to www.swimphone.com and Meet Mobile.**

SCRATCHES: If a swimmer fails to swim in his/her assigned heat and lane for an event, the swim will be marked as NS (No Show) and the swimmer will not be allowed to compete in the remaining heats of the event even if there are empty lanes. An exception may be made at the discretion of the official if there has been an error by the official or a meet worker that caused the swimmer to fail to swim in the assigned heat and lane.

WARM-UP PROCEDURE: Both the competition and south pools will be available for warmup during the entire warmup time. Lanes 2 and 3 in the competition pool will open at 10:30 am as start/sprint lanes, swim in one direction only and exit to the side or end. All other lanes, both pools included, are circle swim only. **NO DIVE STARTS OR BACKSTROKE STARTS** from the blocks or deck in circle swim lanes. Entry into the pool must be feet first in a cautious manner. Lanes in the center and south pool are used for warm up & cool downs, circle swim only, no dives or backstroke starts, during the meet and during warm-ups. One lane will be designated for 65 & Over and Special Needs warmup.

For Your Safety: Swimmers observed diving into any warmup or warm down lane other than designated sprint lanes will be subject to disqualification from all events for the remainder of that day at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
