ROLE OVERVIEW

The Affiliated Organization Liaison is responsible to reach out and act as a liaison with other organizations in order to foster a positive relationship that serves the interests and common goals between each organization. Some examples of other organizations may include: Senior Games, Multi-sport/Triathlon, High School/College Swimming organizations and Local Swimming Committees (LSC).

KEY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with organizations outside of USMS to forward positive relationships to further Adult fitness opportunities.
- Work to promote the mission and vision of USMS with other organizations.
- Develop relationships with other organizations to promote and organize partnership events.
- Provide a positive attitude when troubleshooting with other groups when a concern arises.
- Promote relationships to be knowledgeable about future partnership opportunities.
- Be aware of rules and sanctioning procedures when working to partner with other organizations.
- Foster a venue for recruiting from LSC or college club swimming groups into USMS and the LMSC.

- Strong communication, networking and forward-thinking skills.
- Knowledge of USMS rules.
- Networking with other teams, sports and groups within the LMSC.
