RULES: 1991 USMS LONG DISTANCE SWIMMING RULES
WILL GOVERN THIS EVENT.

BACKGROUND: Long-distance swimming races around a 1/4-mile cable are recognized among North America's oldest competitive swimming events, dating back to the early 1900's.

LOCATION: Glorietta Bay Park, Coronado, California. Take Interstate 5 to San Diego-Coronado Bay Bridge (Hwy 75). Cross bridge (carpools of 2 or more are free in far right-hand lane; others, \$1.00 toll). Turn left on Orange Ave. (75). Proceed to stop-light south of Hotel del Coronado (at the high rises). Turn left, then right onto Strand Way. Park **NORTH** of Municipal Pool and walk south to Glorietta Bay Park (approx. 2 blocks), as parking is limited along Strand Way.

TIME: Heat One: starts at 10:00 a.m.; Heat Two: no earlier than 11:15 a.m.; Heat Three: no earlier than 12:30 p.m.; Heat Four: no earlier than 2:00 p.m. Check-in opens at 9:00 a.m. and closes for each heat 15 minutes prior to its start.

EVENTS: Will be swum on a 1/4-mile course in Glorietta Bay, eight (8) lengths of the cable to be swum for the two-mile distance.

*Heat One-counterclockwise for 19-39 years olds.

*Heat Two-clockwise for 19-39's.


*Heat Three-counterclockwise for 40 and overs.

*Heat Four-clockwise for 40 and overs and all swimmers who expect to take longer than one and one-half hours (ninety minutes) for the two-miles.

NOTE: Swimmers **MUST** swim with their age group heat in order to be eligible for awards and records.

Swimmers stating no preference for a heat will be assigned to one by event officials. Swimmers will not be allowed to change heats on the day of the event. Seeding within heats will be based on time submitted for 1650 yards freestyle (estimate if necessary; do not leave blank).

Swimmers who cannot complete the two-miles in one and one half hours (ninety minutes) should enter Heat Four. Swimmers in heats One, Two, and Three who are still on the course after 1 1/2 hours (ninety minutes) will be stopped and their results recorded as "DID NOT FINISH".

AGE GROUPS: Individual 19-24; 25-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70-74; 75-79; 80-84; 85-89; 90-94; and 95 and over, for both Men and Women.

TEAM EVENT: Age groups will be 19+; 25+; 35+; 45+; 55+; 65+; 75+; and 85+; Men's, Women's and Mixed (2 and 1), three (3) swimmers per team. The age of the youngest team member shall determine the team's age group. Each team entered must declare its three principal swimmers at check-in. Team awards will be based on fastest composite times. All teammates **MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE SAME USMS CLUB.** Mixed sex teams are permitted. Team members must also be individual entrants.

AWARDS: National championship medals will be presented to the top three (3) individual finishers in each age group. These medals will also be presented to each of the three members of the first three teams in each team age group. National champion patches will also be awarded to each first-place finisher, including team event winners.

ENTRY FEES: Payable to "S-I ALL SPORTS". Individual: \$25.00. Team: \$15.00 per team.

REGISTRATION: All swimmers **MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THEIR LOCAL MASTERS SWIM COMMITTEE (LMSC).** ALL entrants **MUST** include a photocopy of their current USMS Registration Card with their entry form. Entries received without a copy of a current card will not be accepted. Please do not arrive at Glorietta Bay, Coronado, on event day planning to register or enter. **ADVANCE REGISTRATION AND ENTRY ARE REQUIRED TO SWIM.**
