The 1992 USMS National Championship 2 Mile Cable Swim will be held at the Clermont Classic. The site of this race is the EAST FORK STATE PARK, located in Clermont County, Ohio between Amelia and Bethel on S.R.125 (approximately 32 miles east of downtown Cincinnati). The two mile swim will start at 9:00 a.m. Saturday, July 18, 1992.

The entry fee is \$20.00. Make checks payable to SOUTHWEST OHIO MASTERS. Mail entries to Dr. Jan C. Huneke, 8068 Asbury Hills Dr., Cincinnati, Ohio 45255 by July 3, 1992. Phone 513-231-8168. Your \$20.00 entry fee includes a souvenir shirt, swim cap, Friday evening "check in" reception, post-race refreshments and final results mailed to you.

All swimmers must be registered with USMS for 1992. "Pending" or "applied for" is not acceptable. You must enclose a copy of your USMS registration card with your entry. If you are not registered, please include an additional \$20.00 with your entry fee and we will provide a USMS registration form for you to sign. Swimmers under the age of 25 are advised that they may jeopardize their amateur standing with FINA and the NCAA if they compete in USMS Swimming.

National Championship medals will be given for first through sixth place finishers in each men's and women's age group. Age as of July 18, 1992 will determine your age group. The age groups are: 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94 and 95 & over.

The "CHECK IN" RECEPTION will be held the evening of Friday, July 17, 1992. The site will be announced in the entry confirmation letter. You should plan to attend to get checked in, pick up your packet (cap, shirt, etc.) and complete any required paperwork. This will facilitate a prompt start on race day. Anyone unable to attend the Friday night check in may check in at the beach between 7 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. on race day.

The Clermont Classic Two Mile Swim will be held in conjunction with the Clermont Classic Triathlon as in past years. (The triathlon will begin 30 minutes before the start of the 2 mile swim.) However, the entry forms are separate. This entry form is for the swim only. If you wish information on the Triathlon contact: Tom Ahlrichs 513-451-5926 between 9:30 a.m. and 9:30 p.m. or send a self addressed stamped envelope to 5317 Sidney Rd., Cincinnati, Ohio 45238.

The swimming course is a 440 yard cable marked at 10 yard intervals with bright orange floats. Two larger floats mark the ends of the cable. Four clockwise circuits (out and back) of this cable must be made to complete the two miles. The start will be from standing in shallow water. The finish will be at the waters edge. The distance from the last buoy to the beach will be compensated for at the start to make the race a true two mile swim.

Directions: East Fork State Park is 9.5 miles east of the intersection of I-275 and Rt. 125. Take Rt. 125 east to Bantam Rd. The park entrance will be on the left 1/4 mile after you get on Bantam. A map will be provided in the entry confirmation letter.
